





Violence from Lebanon to Iraq to the Red Sea all but amounts to an undeclared regional war, with Iran-backed militants fighting Israel and the U.S.








National Debt

- \$34T in debt
- Congress debates 28 cents of every dollar it spends
- Most federal \$ spent w/o congressional deliberation: Medicare, Medicaid, Social Security, other entitlements
- Debt burden slows economic growth, reduces income levels, harms national security posture.
- Constrains funding for strong military & effective diplomacy

National Debt

Public debt exceeds \$34 trillion, debt-to-GDP ratio 120%

Per capita – over \$100,000 per US citizen

Debt-to-income ratio. 1.3 times the national income (GDP)


Annual payment for federal debt interest 4% of the debt per year

Interest expenses account for 5.2% of GDP

Federal tax income = 18% of GDP.

Debt payments are less than 1/3 of income
